The gift will be recorded in the Priory Church in your recipient's name, and we will send you a Gift Certificate recording the details so that you have a proper present to give them on Christmas morning.

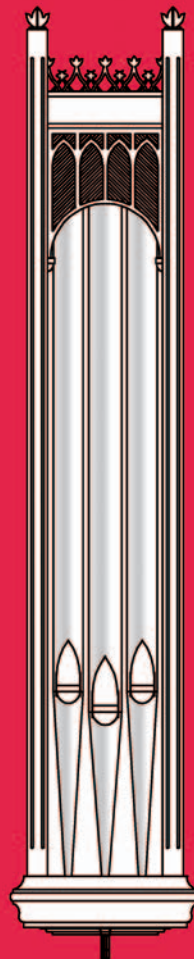
